Acting on circumstances recently occurring, this order is set forth to increase the common courtesy of this Empire. Therefore, if a person is invited to another city, and uses a public transportation terminal, such as an airport or a harbor, that terminal must stay open until the guest leaves. However, the terminal may close if the guest will leave by his consent when the terminal reopens. The terminal may also close if the guest does not leave within a reasonable time, but the guest must be aware of it. To utilize th provisions of this order, the guest should inform the terminal of his estimated departure time. This being said, I hearby enact the above provisions.
