To judge the guilt or innocence of persons charged under federal laws, a series of tribunals inferior to the Supreme Court of the Empire of Diking—to be known as the District Courts of the Empire of Diking—are hereby established. The District Courts of the Empire of Diking shall have original jurisdiction in all cases where a transgression against any law passed by Parliament is alleged. They also shall have original jurisdiction if a citizen of Diking challenges the constitutionality of an emergency executive order, but in no case shall they have any appellate jurisdiction.

There shall be a District Court in each viceroyalty. The court for the Viceroyalty of Corey shall meet in Coland, the court for the Viceroyalty of Chris shall meet in Fort Island, the court for the Viceroyalty of Robert shall meet in Coland, and the Court for the Viceroyalty of Baghdad shall meet in Baghdad.

The Emperor shall nominate a judge for each court with the advice and consent of the individual viceroyalty's Viceroy and lesser Lords. The nominations shall be submitted to the House of Lords for confirmation. Should the House of Lords confirm the nominations, the nominees shall become Judges of the District Court of the Empire of Diking in the viceroyalty for which they were nominated, and the Judges, provided they exhibit good behavior, may hold their positions for life. Should the case load in certain districts become too great for one judge, the Emperor may appoint, in the manner described previously, as many additional judges as are necessary.
